Immunity+ Real World Data

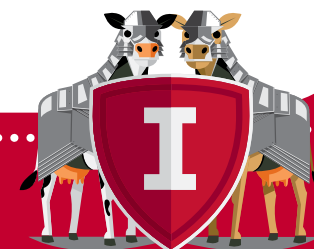
After several years of promoting the use of Immunity+ sires, data is coming in from a variety of large herd sources. The compilation of average rates of decline one can expect from the daughters of Immunity+ sires is represented in the table below. These numbers have been submitted for publication in a scientific journal – they represent real numbers and from just the first generation of selection. Imagine what can be accomplished in improving disease resistance when we have selected for many generations, much like we have for Production or Conformation?

The world these days revolves around the latest exciting genomic sires entering the marketing lineup, and as impressive as a few of ours are this time, the headline spot is deservedly being given to a Proven sire whose second crop daughters are meeting and exceeding expectations. To be fair Monument Impression had lots of reasons for making it onto the mating list in many herds: he was an outcross pedigree (Socrates x Potter) and he extremely balanced in his combination of Production, Type and Health profile. Add high fertility and Immunity+ status and it's easy to understand why he continued to stay popular. There are certain sires that never seem to lose favour. Long after other contemporaries have been replaced on the proof sheet, the rare ones like Impression and Fever continue to stay. The reason: they get cows pregnant, producers like the daughters and they would be happy to have more.

Mr Everything

With due acknowledgment that there is no "perfect" bull, Impression does do quite a lot of things right. He sires good milk yield, even at this stage in his career, offering over 1000 kg of milk yield improvement. Still, it is his excellent combination of strong Mammary, Feet & Legs, Dairy Strength and Rump improvement with his best rating on those traits on Rumps at +11, an area the breed needs a go-to bull for. With low SCS, excellent Mastitis resistance, good Milking Speed and Milking Temperament all contributing to his reliable and excellent Herd Life rating of 112 he is the only bull in the breed to offer this combination. No other Proven or Genomic bulls can match his double digits for all the major Type breakdowns in combination with at least 110 on Herd Life. Impression – if you haven't used him or used him lately, he is definitely worth an encore!

As we do each proof round, here is an introduction to 7 new Genomax bulls that join our proof sheet and a brief description on each.

Progenesis SEDUCER – Supershot x Defender – Our first sire to be released to market with an LPI exceeding 3500, he's also our highest Pro\$ bull at \$2933. He is a Robot Ready sire offering over 170kg of combined fat and protein improvement. He balances it off with nice double-digit type for Udders and Feet & Legs and over 110 ratings for Herdlife and Daughter Fertility. Calving Ability rating suggests he should be fine for use on your best heifers. This is one everyone should include in their next GMate!

Boldi V GYMNAST – Doorsopen x Jabir – at 3448 LPI and bred from an Epic grand dam that is a full sister to the dams of top-flight daughter-proven stars Airintake and Album, Gymnast provides the same +170kg Fat and Protein combination as Seducer, with Robot Ready designation as well and a similar balance of Type and Health too. He's another must-use profit maker. Gymnast is our highest new TPI rated bull at 2712.

View-Home CARDINALS – Yoder x McCutchen – Just under 3400 LPI combined with +13 Type makes this Yoder son our top Immunity+ bull. He's also available in sexed form so let your reps know they can get in line with your confirmed order!

Alphagen MIRADOR – Silver x McCutchen – He's yet another Robot Ready option to work into your GMate. With just under 3300 LPI and +14 Type he offers 110kg of Fat which is only exceeded by Macadam on our proof sheet at 114kg.

Stantons OSCAR – 1stClass x Mogul – With 3282 LPI and +14 Type, it is only his extreme shallow udder rating that prevents him from attaining the Robot Ready designation. Along with Cardinals the pair have the best overall Health trait profiles among our Genomax bulls. Definitely a high value-for-money-spent bull.

Progenesis KEVIN – Elude x 5G – An early Elude son out of a 5G dam who perhaps will have even more upside on Type numbers in April from his current +16 rating. His breakdown includes very attractive numbers for both Udders (+16) and Feet & Legs (+14). He has a strong rating for Herdlife (110) to go along with all that Type too and his Calving Ability rating makes him safe for heifers. Kevin is one of our highest rated bulls for the new Metabolic Disease Resistance trait at 105.

Charpentier COINMONEY – 1stClass x McCutchen – With his +18 Udder rating he is certainly a safe bet to improve overall mammary systems with particular emphasis on shallow udders (14S), udder texture (16) and fore attachment (16). All that Type comes at a very affordable price too.

A NEW TRAIT HAS APPEARED IN OUR GENETIC EVALUATIONS!

On December 6, 2016, genetic evaluations for **Metabolic Disease Resistance (MDR)** were released by Canadian Dairy Network.

Displaced Abomasum's, Clinical and Subclinical Ketosis are all products of a cows environment, as well as her genetics.

Data was collected by DHI on Displaced Abomasum's and Clinical Ketosis from on-farm DairyComp information. Early lactation fat-protein ratios, and body condition scores combined with the analysis of DHI milk sample BHB levels gave a good meter for measuring Subclinical Ketosis.

MDR has a heritability of 7%, showing that genetic selection will be beneficial when combined with good on farm management protocols.



This trait will be expressed as a Relative Breeding Value (RBV) in the functional trait category on an animal's evaluation, with 100 being breed average and higher numbers being more desirable with the goal of creating healthier offspring.

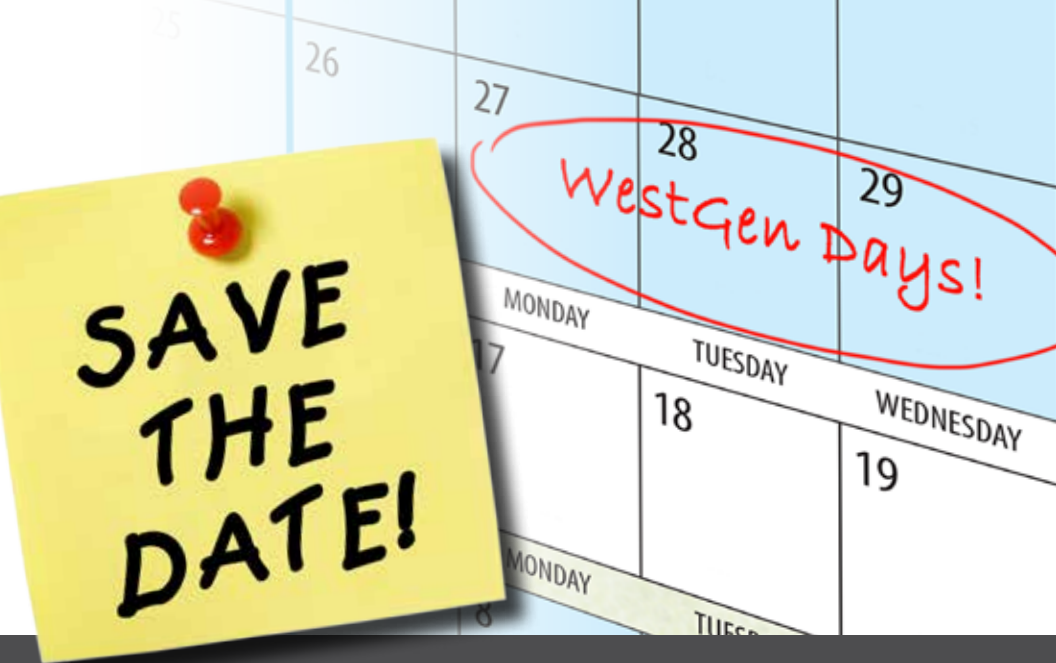
