New Genomax™ Options Are a Recipe for Success

If you’re given the name “Incredibull” you’d better be able to back it up. In the case of **Riverdown INCREDIBULL-Red** (Dresser x Applejack Red), it would appear that he was appropriately named. His outcross sire to Red pedigrees, OCD McCutchen Dresser is built from 5 generations of non-red carriers (Observer, Goldwyn, Durham, Outside and Jed). On his maternal side, he is the first red sire to hit AI too. Odds are, people will use him for his +16 Conformation rating in combination with over 3000 LPI. The outcross aspect that makes him so compelling will simply be a bonus.



Incredibull-Red has that impressive Type rating that jumps out – even more perhaps because his production numbers are also strong. With a DVG Type score of +18 and a GPA Conformation rating of +16, he is easily the highest available Type bull over 3000 LPI. His profile suggests key strengths will be udders and feet & legs while being more moderate on frame and rump improvement. The easy suggestion is to use him on anything you want to turn to red or keep red!

Silverridge V ERIC (Lottomax x McCutchen) is our first Lottomax son from a McCutchen full/maternal sister to the Semex bulls Envious, Endure and Wickham and the same family as Elude, Extreme and Entail. Eric’s +3316 LPI is complemented by his +17 Conformation and is supported by a very attractive health trait profile as well. This family is proving its worth with many people commenting favourably about early daughters of Elude and Wickham. Why use Eric? The added element of Immunity+™ is certainly a big reason, but a balanced bull with Type as his long suit is a proven recipe for success in selecting Genomax sires with a future. Expect exceptional udders and feet & legs with high milk and fat yields, supported by a no-holes health profile including calving ability.



Progenesis ORION (Kingboy x Mogul) with remarkably similar numbers to Eric, sports 3328 LPI, +17 Type and also the Immunity+ designation. Orion will sire lots of milk and combine it with a very attractive Type breakdown for udders, feet & legs, and dairy strength. Add to that a nice health trait profile including calving ability, and this becomes another bull that follows that same recipe for success. The Immunity+ designation is a nice bonus feature.



Three new bulls to consider – all three with compelling reasons to be used. The Genomax lineup continues to offer exceptional new choices while the latest graduates reinforce the strategy.



Tour of the new building during WestGen days!

The GeneBank goal is simply to make participation in the creation and ownership of top genetic females more affordable to Western Canadian producers. It fits extremely well within WestGen's societal mandate.

The original concept for GeneBank was that all participants would share in the harvest of both frozen and fresh embryos. That option still exists, however we have had a number of producers express interest in either having us implant all the embryos for them at Boviteq West, while some others are only interested if they can avoid the need to purchase pregnant recipients. Thus the program is evolving into three options for producers:

Option 1

Receive: 4 Frozen embryos shipped for implantation on farm

Cost: \$4500

Option 2

Receive: 2 Frozen embryos shipped for implantation on farm plus 1 guaranteed pregnancy generated from embryos implanted at Boviteq West.

Cost: \$3500 + purchase of 1 recipient

Option 3

Receive: 2 guaranteed pregnancies generated from embryos implanted at Boviteq West.

Cost: \$2500 + purchase of 2 recipients

All 3 options have the intention of creating two live calves from the investment for each participant. We will be purchasing the first heifers for the program in the coming days – call us if you are curious about the pedigrees, have other questions, or if you wish to participate in this exciting program!

Open the door to possibility...

Doorman delivers

Val-Bisson Doorman is the quintessential new-age sire who shows how our new method of sire selection, while riskier, still has the checks and balances needed to provide protection. Today we stand a month away from Doorman delivering his first Canadian official proof, and we can say with relative certainty that type-oriented Canadian producers will be more than pleased for having gotten an early jump on this great bull.

Doorman arrived on the scene in the fall of 2012 and his extremely attractive combination for LPI and Conformation made him an instant hit with producers, despite that little was known about his sire Bookem or that Bookem's sire, Planet, wasn't really noted for delivering extreme Type. A few months later, he was designated an Immunity+™ sire which added another intriguing element to his profile. Later came a reputation for high fertility and, while many Genomax bulls that join the WestGen marketing list enjoy 2 to 3 tours of duty (otherwise known as proof rounds), Doorman managed to stay on the list longer. Then, just when he would have given way to a new recruit, his calves in pens across the country began generating a second wave of interest that gave him another reprieve. All the while, Doorman's numbers remained remarkably steady as well- he didn't look out of place. In fact, high ranking sons started joining him and instead, his aura continued to grow.

Today, it's doubtful many people breeding cows to Doorman refer much to his proof information. That's quite ironic, because despite that we know so much about Doorman's breeding pattern, he is yet to receive his first official Canadian daughter proof! Meanwhile we have already marketed a number of Doorman sons and will soon see sons from his first daughters join the list. We are also less than 6 months away from seeing the earliest sons from his sons hit the market (like the first sons from Doorsopen). By comparison, a few short years ago we would just now be starting to flush top cows to Doorman to make his first sons... What a dramatic change!

It is clear that Doorman is a Type bull. In particular, to those who appreciate the Canadian definition of Dairy Strength, there will be few bulls that can match Doorman on delivering improvement here. They are wide chested without being coarse. However, this Immunity+ sire does so much more than add frame. They are high component cattle carrying exceptional

mammary systems, with especially well attached fore udders and slightly longer teats. Feet & legs display excellent foot structure, good tracking, as well as good bone quality. On rumps, while impressive in their width, pins can be on the higher side of average with thurls set back a bit.

Doorman will certainly be more of a Type bull than a Health trait bull. That said, he does deliver extremely low somatic cell score and good mastitis resistance as many Immunity+ bulls do. There is no denying that he makes some slower milking cows. That's probably the area to protect him on and to that point, logical mates include Numero Uno and Meridian daughters who are typically extremely fast for milk out, and who could use the added length of rib and width of chest Doorman can offer. Another excellent cross would be Brawler daughters, again for the reasons of supporting Dairy Strength. Although they are both Bookem sons, Doorman also matches well on McCutchen daughters, who could use Doorman's added width and depth. If concerned about the inbreeding level, skip a generation and use him on daughters of McCutchen sons instead. Finally, Doorman is an excellent cross for Mogul daughters and daughters of many of his sons. They are more moderate in frame and benefit from the low cell counts that Doorman delivers, while helping to keep the pins down. There are certainly lots of places for Doorman to make a contribution to breeding programs across Western Canada.

In today's world of genetics, where a good proof validates usage of sons and grandsons more than the individual getting the daughter proof, it's true that Doorman (who receives a proof in April) is a solid endorsement as well for his best sons. Still, in Doorman's case, he may be that rare individual that merits continued usage himself, too. It's clear that he's an outlier whose influence will be felt for generations. Particularly for those wanting the certainty of stellar Type, he is bankable for delivering precisely that. With 300 daughters classified, he maintains an 87% GP and better rating, and so far, with already 60 VG-2-yr-olds to his credit, that's 20% of his young daughter group and an unheard of ratio for an emerging bull. Doorman opens the door to possibility - he invites dreamers to dream and better yet, he delivers!



EVERGRAZE MASTER BREEDER

Terry Wagner and family of Evergraze Holsteins earned their second Master Breeder Shield in 2015, just 16 years after she and her late husband Bob were awarded this honor the first time. The Wagners recently welcomed the first two members of the 4th generation to join Evergraze Holsteins with the November births of Brooklyn to Marc & Kelsey, and Brynn to Michelle & Doug. They join a family that's loved working with good Holsteins for 55 years, since Wilf Wagner bought the farm on Highway 97A in Armstrong. In 1980, son Bob purchased the farm and continued to pursue his passion of breeding and showing high type Holsteins.

The Evergraze herd consists of 40 Holsteins who are thriving in their brand new home, a Lely robot freestall barn that they started up in October. Prior to moving into the new barn, the herd was milked in a single 4 Surge parlour, and housed in an old model freestall barn that was constructed in 1959. Since moving to the automated milking barn, the herd has reached an average of 39kg with 3.9%F and 3.1%P. All grain is fed through the robot and cows visit an average of 3.8 times/day. The herd produces high quality milk with 69,000 SCC and 7000 bacteria count. This production is achieved with home grown orchard grass forage harvested 4x/year.

The Wagners breed for type and good feet and legs and find that this results in cows that milk well and have longevity. The herd classification breakdown speaks volumes about the success they've had with this strategy, as the herd currently includes 2-4E,

4-3E, 5-2E, 5 EX, 24 VG and 8 GP! Bulls that worked well in the past include Storm, Counsellor, Outside, Spirit, and Blitz. Some of their current service sires include Solomon, Dempsey, Aftershock, Dundee and Unix. Though they've done some ET work in the past, they aren't currently. The herd is basically closed except for the occasional offspring of partnership cattle that return to the farm.

Terry has long played a very active role in the local Holstein industry, having sat on North Okanagan Holstein Club committees, been an IPE dairy director for years, and the Holstein Club Show Committee Chairperson. Now, daughter Michelle is taking her turn and currently serves as the treasurer of the NOHC. The future of the farm is in good hands, with both Marc and Michelle passionate about the business and enjoying the more flexible lifestyle that a robot milking system brings. They're comfortable with their current herd size, and have plenty of space in the barn to take advantage of quota allocations as they come.

All of us at WestGen congratulate the Wagners on their remarkable achievement and look forward to celebrating with them at the National Holstein Convention in Banff this April!
